        switch(inApp.Execute())
        {
            // for this I need the LPARAM and WPARAM:

                inApp.getMidiInData(lpGot);
                break;
            case WM_KEYDOWN:
                PromptOK(t_("Want to quit proggy?"));
                return;
        }

    inApp.Run();
}
```
