I do prefer using SVN versions because U++ itself is rather stable and I have no problems with it`s stability for months. When you rebuild TheIDE from SVN sources, you will see something like "r170" in your Assist/About dialog.

If you want latest SVN version, you may install any SVN client (i.e. TortoiseSVN), then do SVN "Checkout" on your UPP directory. SVN server to use is: http://upp-mirror.googlecode.com/svn/trunk/
