Class x:

```
tabdlg.dbgrid1.AddColumn("ID");
tabdlg.dbgrid1.AddColumn("Date");
tabdlg.dbgrid1.AddColumn("Value");
tabdlg.dbgrid1.AddColumn("Paid");
tabdlg.dbgrid1.ColumnWidths("0 50 50 200");
tabdlg.dbgrid1.WhenLeftDouble = THISBACK(OnAnuidDBClick);
```

tabdlg is a member of the class x. It is also defined in the .h of the class x like this:
