You have several options here:

- Use the `DockWindow::WindowButtons` function to remove the close button from all it's child windows
 - You can use the Docking config window to manage all of the `DockWindows`, but only one at a time. Just call `DockWindow::DockManager` on the window you want to manage.
 - Provide some custom method for controlling the windows. The `DockMenu` class is provided to support custom menus. Or perhaps you could have a toolbar with window icons, and when the user clicking on them would call `DockWindow::ActiveDockable` to restore it to it's last position.
