I thought since it is so hard to get the problematic fonts look right, I would write something that would work fine for non-problematic fonts and then try to figure out where the difference is. I obtained a very basic version which draws diacritics by composition, even if precomposed character are available in font. I used step by step comparison to try to get the proportions right.

And even though I succeed in most cases, it is very hard to determine a general formula bases only on character height, ascent and descent. I will need base height and x-height also. Looking over XGlyphInfo it seems that it is possible to get the exact height and width of a given character.

Also, using the macron character will yield uniformly horrible results, so I replaced it with a basic '̀'.

I wonder how is this effort different from existing code?
