What MingW is actually complaining about here is not the use of the initialiser list, but that the list is in a different order than the member variables are declared. Frankly I cannot see the purpose of such a warning, so I'm not going to spend the time fixing it. The same goes for all of the unnecessary parenthesis warnings, because I was aware of operator precedence when I wrote the code thank you very much MingW

All of those missing returns and unused variables (usually from debugging) were very good to fix though.
