Novo wrote on Sun, 08 February 2009 17:59: In which way tab stacking is better than nested tabs? Nested tabs seem to be a natural representation of hierarchy.

I'm not sure I understand the question. Stacking is an internal function of the TabBar, but nested tabs can be implemented externally by combining multiple TabBars. The docking package will continue to use nesting.

TheIde could have a similar system by using two TabBars, one for the file group and one for individual files, and this is easy to do without any internal changes to TabBar.

Whatever system is used in TheIde will not be decided by me, I only implemented tab stacking because I thought it was cool
