You just see what is inside of a group. No need to decode content of a tab name. You can group open files by package names instead of just names.

Well, what I was trying to say was that it is not a choice between the two. You could have nested tabs for the package groups, and then a separate option for stacking files by name within the groups. The criteria used for stacking files can be different to that used for grouping them.
