What if I want to take some action on middle button click? I think a more generic solution would be something like a WhenClicked action which gets the mouse position in parameter, and would have a default proxy to WhenBar & WhenLeftClick & WhenLeftDouble.

Well, I believe that if your code depends on actual mouse position, it is much better to simply derive ArrayCtrl and override LeftDown....

In other words, following this path, we would ended with callbacks for each single virtual method of Ctrl.
