Hi, I think I can't provide date format by burning it on the source code because I want my application compliant with internationalization, which means that, if it is executed on France, it gets the format from the underlying SO or something and show dates in french format. If I burn the format then the format is always the same

Another option is to ask for the user (on the first app launch) the choosed date format and then respect it always.
