Mindtraveller wrote on Sat, 09 May 2009 16:40Solution could be straightforward: SVN server could generate some file (like version.h with single line like "define UPP_REVISION 1153") which could be included into U++ and used.

Sure, this what we use for releases.

Anyway, with svn itself the situation is a little bit more complex. I could do what you propose, BUT it would mean that each commit to svn would generate another revision just for the sake of fixing version.h (to commit changed version.h).

Another option is to add svnversion support to the ide compile process.

I have to say neither option looks good enough for me now. Besides, is it so much hard to run svnversion on your trunk copy before posting a message here?

(In any case, you should always check with svn head to find out whether the bug was not fixed meanwhile).

Anyway, back to the topic. Does DnD work for you now or not?
