Recently I've searched internet for SCIM discussions. Well, SCIM is told to be installed by default on Ubuntu with a number of localizations - actually not only Asian, but even for some Cyrillic ones (but they actually don't need it).

And it looks like SCIM is known to be buggy with a relatively large number of applications as it has incorrect input focus hooking behaviour in some situations. Thus it is sometimes recommended to use SCIM alternatives instead of original utility.

Hope this little info will help.
