I have included the directories in the Package Organizer using the -I option. It works for GCC/MinGW and MSC.

So for both compilers the program works well. For now perhaps it is enough but I think it is nicer to include the include directories as an explicit Package option...

... But I have a problem with MSC: Both XIsLibs and \Microsoft SDKs\Windows\v6.1\Include have a file named rectypes.h

To avoid errors, XIsLib directories have to be before SDK directories. Unfortunately it seems Upp

- First reads Build Methods
- Second reads Package Organizer

So in this case:

- Or I have to do dirty things: renaming rectypes.h in SDKs

- Or I have to put XIsLib include directories in Build Methods, and before \Microsoft SDKs\Windows\v6.1\Include
