This simple console program will reproduce the problem:

```
#include <stdio.h>
#include <unistd.h>

int main( int argc, const char* argv[] )
{
    fprintf(stderr, "start\n");
    usleep(20000*1000);
    fprintf(stderr, "stop\n");
}
```

when running in the debugger (F5), the console doesn't show and pressing shift-F5 to stop debugging within the 20 seconds of the sleep will hang Thelde until the programs ends by itself.

However, when I use ctrl-F5 the console shows fine, and I can see the printf's.
