I've tried to build theide with -m32 option for 32bit but it's still linking with 64 bit version of ld-linux-x86-64.so as i said in a previous post. I think it's possible not to link with it but you will lose the dynamic loading of *.so, it means that we will not be able to use DLI for runtime.
