Hello, Jan.

In the first post on this topic you said about left mouse click instead of right mouse click. I guess, you think of EditField behaviour (CtrlLib/EditField.cpp):

void EditField::RightDown(Point p, dword keyflags)
{
    keep_selection = true;
    MenuBar::Execute(THISBACK(MenuBar));
    SetFocus();
    keep_selection = false;
}
```

The AssistEditor have LineEdit behaviour (CtrlLib/LineEdit.cpp):

```
void LineEdit::RightDown(Point p, dword flags)
{
    mpos = GetMousePos(p);
    SetWantFocus();
    int l, h;
    if(!GetSelection(l, h) || mpos < l || mpos >= h)
        PlaceCaret(mpos, false);
    MenuBar::Execute(WhenBar);
}
```

The fix maybe as follows (also for DocEdit):

```
void LineEdit::RightDown(Point p, dword flags)
{
    mpos = GetMousePos(p);
    MenuBar::Execute(WhenBar);
    SetWantFocus();
    int l, h;
    if(!GetSelection(l, h) || mpos < l || mpos >= h)
        PlaceCaret(mpos, false);
```
