I think that the same kind of bug is in [] operator in String - it returns n-th byte instead of n-th letter. This example works fine:

```
SetDefaultCharset(CHARSET_UTF8);  
String first_name = "John";  
String second_name = "Wayne";  
String login = first_name[0] + second_name;  
PromptOK(login);
```

But this one doesn't:

```
SetDefaultCharset(CHARSET_UTF8);  
  
String second_name = "Wayne";  
String login = first_name[0] + second_name;  
PromptOK(login);
```
