A sample that works for me is in GridCtrl.cpp, function GridCtrl::SetClipboard, where the separation between rows is with `\r\n` and between columns is with `\t`.

This way the cells are pasted well in MS Excel and in Open Office.

A thing to care with is not to add additional tabs per row as in GridCtrl. This additional tab deletes the next column in Excel.

So to copy this:

First Row
Second Row

it has to be passed to the clipboard this:

"First\tRow\r\nSecond\tRow"

instead of this:

"First\tRow\t\r\nSecond\tRow\t"
