Right now, we have stepped back in this:

Nightly builds are -src and -win32 only. Announced releases should come each 14 days (+/-), koldo will copy nightly build to sf.net and based on it, release maintainers will create platform specific packages and individually upload to sf.net.

So, the sort answer is: YES. But wait for sources to appear on sf.net (as signal that we called some particular svn revision a "release").
