It is ready, tested in WinXP and Ubuntu, documented and submitted to Bazaar.

The demo program has been adapted to include this option.

It can output native executable files in Linux and Windows, I mean, when compiling the main program under Linux the executable obtained will be Linux native (ELF format), and when compiling it in Windows the executable will be Windows native (PE-COFF format).

This way the output program can be simply called and run for example from a terminal.

The main visible changes are in:

```
void SetOutputExe();  
void SetOutputMemory();  
  
void Link(const char *fileName = 0);
```

This fileName is the executable file.

Please read the instructions before using it.
