Sorry, my mistake. I had to replace upp's SqlInsert with "query in string" + ExecuteX to insert many rows at once, and I've used ~CurrVal(). That's why I had this funny version of curval.

BTW. Is there a way to force SqlInsert, to create single insert with many rows:
