I update it directly from the UPP SVN

repository by using the hgpullsvn utility.

The pending hgpushsvn utility also exists.

So I use HG locally while the repo is still under SVN.

This approach could be a good test before deciding SCM A or B

I completely agree with this. GIT can be easily synchronized with SVN. If your favorite DVCS doesn't have native synchronization support, then you can use Tailor (<http://progetti.arstecnica.it/tailor>).
