It's not a problem the package will work in any of the ubuntu versions (and in debian as well). Just change the corresponding line in your /etc/apt/sources.list to say lucid instead of karmic. I'll have a look if it's possible to make the repo universal...

I'm sorry, but I was lying here. It actually does matter what ubuntu version it is built for. Lucid has newer version of libc, so it doesn't work on karmic. Thanks to Andrei for pointing this out. I've added karmic builds to the repository now. Should I also add some older? Theoretically we can go
