```
cc = ln.GetCount();  
for ( int i = 0; i < cc; i++ ){  
    ic = (ln[i]); ch = ic;
```

Somewhere before, or after this if String ln == ""; and I passed it to a function while debugging it would throw an error similar to this and pull up String.h
