On the command got up to compiling the HelloWorld.c code.

```
cl -Ic:\java\include -Ic:\java\include\win32 -MD -LD HelloWorld.c -FeHelloWorld.dll
```

and get this error:

I have included in the path C:\Program Files\Java\jdk1.7.0\include where jni.h is located
