I have this now:

```
if (!readOnly)
    gridPlantas.Accept();
else
    gridPlantas.Reject();
```

I have tried this, but the results are the same:

```
for (int row = 0; row < grid.GetRowCount(); ++row)
    for (int col = 0; col < grid.GetColumnCount(); ++col)
        grid.GetItem(row, col).Editable(!readOnly); (GetItem is really private )
```

I have not found an Editable() method for rows.
