Hello,

I need to find a substring in "whole word" mode.

For example, if I look for "Lui" and the string is

"my name is Luigi" the search should produce no result as I want just "Lui" and not "Luigi". The sign ",.:;" should be considered white space.

This feature is available for example in the "Find in Files..." option in the IDE. I was not able to find a similar option neither in the String method nor in Bazaar.

Is it really not available or am I blind?
