I need to find a substring in "whole word" mode.

It seems the RegExp library does the job. Something like this:

```
String p = "(\\b" + pattern + "\\b)";
RegExp r0(p);
if( r0.Match( mystring ) ) { ... }
```

is able to find the string pattern in whole word mode. The trick was to set the \b at the begin and at the end of the wanted string.
