In C++ isolation - by modules, because combine header files and combine layout files OR split header files and split layout files.
(I split dialog and main window into different files)

Use Button variable name ok - and change from CtrlLayout to CtrlLayoutOK - logic of work added automatically.
(I change variable name from Cerrar to ok - and method Close is gone...)

Don't forget add
#define LAYOUTFILE <prueba/dialogo.lay>
#include <CtrlCore/lay.h> for every dialog
and for every class.
