You got it almost right Javier. The only problem is that iml\_source.h must be included only once.

How it works: iml\_header.h provides declarations, while iml\_source.h provides definitions. So you must use iml\_source.h only once, doesn't matter where, and only put the iml\_header.h code in the rest of the places where necessary. Otherwise you get linker errors about multiple definitions.

In your case everything you have to do to get it work is to remove the definition from one of the cpp files (that is step 2 or step 4).
