Hi Jeremy,

The syncing options should be in Edit > SVN submenu. Similar options are present in the context menu that appears when you right click on file or package on the left side of the ide:

It should open a window with list of changed files and, most importantly, commit button.

If you don't see these options or the window doesn't appear, it is either problem with you svn installation (but then neither the svn history would work, so it is probably not the case) or it might be a bug.

Maybe you could try the standalone usvn client. It is in uppsrc, just compile it and run in your working copy directory. It is the same code as in the ide, so if there is some problem in the code, it should be broken too and possibly easier to debug.
