even if that leads to things like
if (10 <= i && i <= 13) ... //i is as expected inside 10..13 range

So 2 <= GetCount() looks reasonably to me.

Anyway, single "=" in if does produce warning anyway, until you use the more complex way like in my post (that's why I'm doing it, so I can detect mistakes from warnings).
