Hi Javier,

Simple answer: Each bit in keyflag stands for one action (not necessarily key press). The easiest way to check what is pressed is using the K_* enums defined in CtrlCore:enum {

K_DELTA = 0x010000,
```

```
K_ALT = 0x080000,
K_SHIFT = 0x040000,
K_CTRL = 0x020000,
```

 $K_KEYUP = 0x100000$,

```
K_MOUSEMIDDLE = 0x200000,
```

 $K_MOUSERIGHT = 0x400000,$

K MOUSELEFT = 0x800000,

 $K_MOUSEDOUBLE = 0x1000000,$

K MOUSETRIPLE = 0x2000000,

```
K_SHIFT_CTRL = K_SHIFT|K_CTRL, };
```

So to check if alt and shift are pressed you would do keyflags&(K ALT|K SHIFT) etc.

More generally, there are bool GetShift(), GetCtrl(), GetAlt(), GetCapsLock() and GetMouse*() functions, which can be used to query the keys and mousebuttons anywhere in the code. Those are not used much. Incidentally, I just found them yesterday
