but in this case Duo<int,int> work, because there the items are named explicitly.

the advantage is, that you don't always want to store all data inside Value, but as an explicit type.

but using same type one might think of using Duo<String, Vector<int> >, grouping it

it is still a development, so expect some changes here. but the idea is to loosely group stuff together without the need to create a whole new class for it.. it's maybe considered a class template, instead of a template class. a public members class.
