A small bug: I'd like to use the "export" feature, using that syntax (my locale is fr_FR.UTF-8): \$ make -f uppbox/lpbuild/Makefile PKG=ide FLAGS="GUI MT" export Exporting uppbox/lpbuild/Makefile to Makefile.export ... make[1]: [ide] Erreur 1 (ignorée) \$ cat Makefile.export .PHONY:default default: all \$ What? That's all? Seems it's missing some content. Next I try to use the C locale:

\$ export LC_ALL=C \$ make -f uppbox/lpbuild/Makefile PKG=ide FLAGS="GUI MT" export Exporting uppbox/lpbuild/Makefile to Makefile.export ... make[1]: [ide] Error 1 (ignored) \$ cat Makefile.export [whole content, so it works]

So I suggest the subprocesses are executed with the locale set to C, so that words parsing later works.

UPDATE: I also changed one line for more precise output, so that you understand why yours may differ: line 337, I changed \$(call echo," Exporting makefile to \$(EXPORT) ...") to \$(call echo," Exporting \$(filename) to \$(EXPORT) ...")
