Not sure what are you speaking about here.

In any case, I have tested

```
struct Foo {  
    int x;  
};  
  
CONSOLE_APP_MAIN  
{  
    Tuple2<int, Foo> x;  
    DDUMP(sizeof(x));  
}
```

and no problems with both GCC and MSC.

Of course adding

```
x == x;
```

invokes errors in both compilers.
