As for the licenses, we are trying to keep it as permissive as possible. And nobody is forced to use mingw. I am not sure what is current state of llvm, but last time I checked it was working only for C, not C++. And clang is not ready to compile U++ yet, I think...

Anyway if you are that much into permissive licenses, you should probably abandon windows platform and start using something else, let's say some BSD system. Then you'd have not problems with mingw, sdl etc.
