into Sqlexp.h:

```
SqlSet&      Limit(const unsigned int limit);  
SqlSet&      Limit(const unsigned int offset, const unsigned int limit);  
SqlSet&      Offset(const unsigned int offset);
```

into Sqlexp.cpp:

```
SqlSet& SqlSet::Limit(const unsigned int limit) {  
    text << " limit " << limit;  
    return *this;  
}
```

```
SqlSet& SqlSet::Limit(const unsigned int offset, const unsigned int limit) {  
    text << " limit " << offset << ", " << limit;  
    return *this;  
}
```

```
SqlSet& SqlSet::Offset(const unsigned int offset) {  
    text << " offset " << offset;  
    return *this;  
}
```

After OrderBy it would be the right place.
