I've 4 beautyfull tab pages (tab1,..., tab4). In corrispondence of an action performed in tab1, I desire that tab2 be displayed... and maybe the focus should be on button btnAuto of tab2... but this last task is not necessary.

How to do it? To show tab2 I tried:

```
ActiveFocus(tab2);
```

ActiveFocus(tab2.btnAuto);
```

tab2.btnAuto.SetFocus();
```

tab2.btnAuto.GetFocusCtrl();
```

none of them work. Any idea?

_top - index of tab

focus - move focus to the first child

String GetExeDirFile(const char *fp);
```

- file from the .exe folder

```
String GetExeFilePath();
```

- full path to .exe

Means, .exe folder is `GetFileFolder(GetExeFilePath());`

Current working directory:

```
String GetCurrentDirectory();
```
