I do not know the type of timeConverter. However doing this:

```

int64 g1 = t.Get();
```

```
StrToDate(t, "1/1/20 0:0:1");
```

```
int64 g2 = t.Get();
```

```
StrToDate(t, "1/1/21 0:0:1");
```

```
int64 g3 = t.Get();
```

I get:

```
g1 = 63713520000
```

```
g2 = 60589296000
```

```
g3 = 60620918400
```

This is not important as using two digits years is very unsafe from 2000 year. Doing this:

```

int64 g1 = t.Get();
```

StrToDate(t, "1/1/2020 0:0:1");
```

```
int64 g2 = t.Get();
```

```

int64 g3 = t.Get();
```

I get:

g1 = 63713520000
```

```
g2 = 63745056000
```

```
g3 = 63776678400
```

that looks better .

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
