So:

- Atomic vars has to be handled using AtomicXXX() functions
- Variables handled with Mutex are declared normally, but all use of them (read or write) has to be between an Enter() and a Leave()

Yes. I would just add that Atomic can be handled as int if you know that no clash can happen (i.e. when only one thread can access it at given moment). Similar with mutex, you can skip the locking if you are sure that there is only one thread executing that code. But those are details and being more cautious than necessary does never hurt
