Hi Fisiu,

You have seen how I package the Arch packages (and the Ubuntu packages are the same). I would recommend you to follow the same structure - separate package for the source codes (the standard set is bazaar,reference,examples,uppsrc and tutorial) and another one for the ide binary. As mr_ped said, ide sources are integral part of the framework (some other packages need to include ide to work properly!), so you should probably leave it there.

I hope you are aware that there are already RPM packages being released for stable versions (<http://sourceforge.net/projects/upp/files/upp/2791/>) and that there was even some attempt to build packages in OBS <https://build.opensuse.org/package/show?package=ultimatepp∓project=Education> (but it is apparently not updated). Maybe you could reuse a lot of information from those packages to save you work.

Anyway, if you can arrange regular builds in OBS, it would be definitely great for U++. So good luck and don't be afraid to ask here if you need help
