arr.AddColumn("first",1);
arr.AddColumn("second",2);
arr.AddColumn("third",3);
String arrColumnWidths;
for (int i=0; i<arr.GetColumnCount();i++){
    arrColumnWidths << AsString(arr.HeaderObject().GetTabWidth(i))+ " ";
}
arr.ColumnWidths(arrColumnWidths); //set widths from string "1 2 3"
PromptOK(arrColumnWidths); //have in mind now they are in pixels...
