Hi Neil,

I failed to reproduce the problem you describe. The way you use `ExecuteOpen()` seems correct, it should return false when closing the window or hitting Cancel. I tested with GCC and with MinGW. Are you using `FileSel` or `FileSelector`? Maybe if you post a complete, compilable testcase that shows the wrong behavior we can figure out what is the problem...

Also, I don't really understand what are you trying to do with the `r_d` and `recent_dir`. Both `fn` and `~fn` return the same thing, the difference being that once it is string, and the second is value, but in the end they are used in `Nvl`, so I deduce they are same type or they are converted to the same type upon use, so I don't see much sense to have them both. But that is not really related to the problem.
