This reminded me some ideas which other forums have:

1. restrict users with 0 messages not to be allowed to put www links? Does anyone know how technically to do this with fudforum?

And/or

2 force users with 0 messages to post at least one introductory message into a special "say hello" forum section which e.g could be restricted to viewing for logged users only. And only after that allow to post to other sections.

And/or

3 require to answer a simple poll/questionnaire in that "say hello" section.

This way we could also gather some statistics how they had found us, what they expect, and maybe make them feel more welcome etc.
