```
if(focusCtrl) focusCtrl->SetWndForeground();
```

I believe it should have been

```
if(activate) wnd->SetWndForeground();
```

What works is:

```
if(activate) {  
// topwindow->SetWndForeground(); //this prevents menus in OSX11  
  focusCtrl->SetWndForeground();  
}
```
