I need to keep track of the edit status of the current row in a ArrayCtrl. I connected a callback to its WhenUpdateRow event.

```
void TransactionCtrl::TransactionUpdateRow()
{
    int i;
    if(trans.IsCursor() )
    {
        i=trans.GetCursor();
        msgs.Insert(-1, String().Cat()<<"Cursor at "<<i<<"\n");
    }else
        return;
    if( trans.IsModified(i))
    {
        changed=true;
        msgs.Insert(-1, "MODIFIED - IN Update Row\n");
    }
}
```

It never worked as I had expected. By the way, the column I tested is using  
trans.AddColumn("Name").Edit>AnEditStringObject);
