E: Unable to lock directory /var/lib/apt/lists/ This means just that you either had some other instance of apt/apt-get/aptitude/synaptics/... running at the same time (only one is allowed, to protect database integrity).

upp:

Depends: g++ but it is not going to be installed or

g++ but it is not going to be installed

Well, this is strange. The g++ is really a dependency, but there should be no problem installing it and Synaptics should be clever enough to install it. At least it worked for me last time I installed upp on Lucid...

Anyway, you can try to run the script once more, this time making sure it is the only program trying to access the package database. If it fails in some other way this time, please send me the full output of the script. Or you can try to set things up manually, it is actually just three commands:

```
sudo add-apt-repository ppa:dolik-rce/upp-nightly
```

```
sudo apt-get update
```

```
sudo apt-get install upp
```
