menus2={ "menu": "MainMenu", "submenus": "MainSubmenu1" };
```

```
x<<to_string(menus1)<<"\n";  
x<<to_string(menus1)<<"\n";
```

OUTPUT:

```
{ void: "MainSubmenu1" }  
{ "menu": "MainMenu" }, "submenus": "MainSubmenu1" }
```
