Library wsck32 is windows-only, so it is of course not present on your Ubuntu. I believe you are using it in your package's code (since I couldn't find it anywhere in U++), so you will have to rewrite the code to support linux as well (either using some multiplatform library, or using `#ifndef PLATFORM_WIN32`).

If you tell us what are you using the library for, someone might be able to advise you on how to make it work on both win and linux...
